

## **Brownsfields Regulation - O. Reg. 153/04 has been Amended**

On December 29, 2009, the Ontario government made changes to its brownfields regulation (O. Reg. 153/04). The amendments filed under O. Reg. 511/09 were posted on the province's e-laws website at:

These amendments have yet to be published in the Ontario *Gazette*.

A majority of the amendments do not come into force until July 1, 2011 so there appears to be sufficient notice for proponents to fully understand the nature of the amendments and react accordingly.

The reforms, which took into account public consultation from the spring of 2007, aims to put more brownfields into productive use while safeguarding public health and safety.
